

Recently

I can't part with any of my automation rules

Let's review your existing automation rules

Identify if it needs to be an automation

Consider whether you need an automation or there's a different way to achieve your goal

Prioritize essential automations

Remove nice-to-have automations and focus on those that are business-critical (e.g., avoid automations for minor updates)

Refine automation triggers

Adjust the triggers for your rules and add conditions so automations only run when needed

Decide between global vs. projectspecific automations

If an automation doesn't need to be global, limit it to specific projects to save processing and automation runs

Remove obsolete automations

Find and remove redundant rules (e.g., turn off rules for temporary projects)

Merge and consolidate automations

Combine multiple rules that are doing similar things into one automation. Try if/else conditions!

Adjust the automation frequency

Adjust their schedule so they only run when necessary (e.g., 1-2 times a day during off-peak hours)
